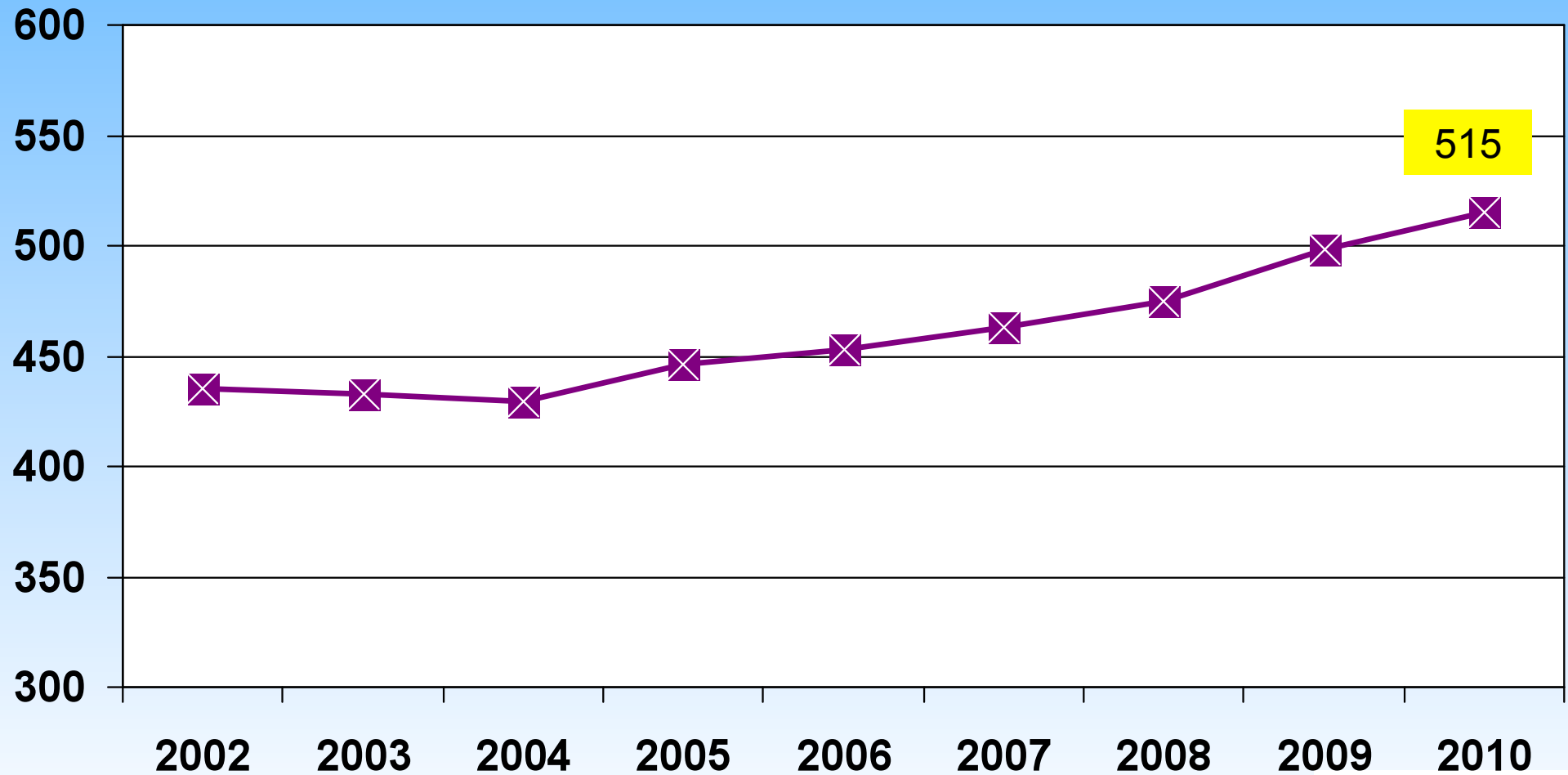

- ◆ SSRE is represented in the World Education Research Association (WERA)

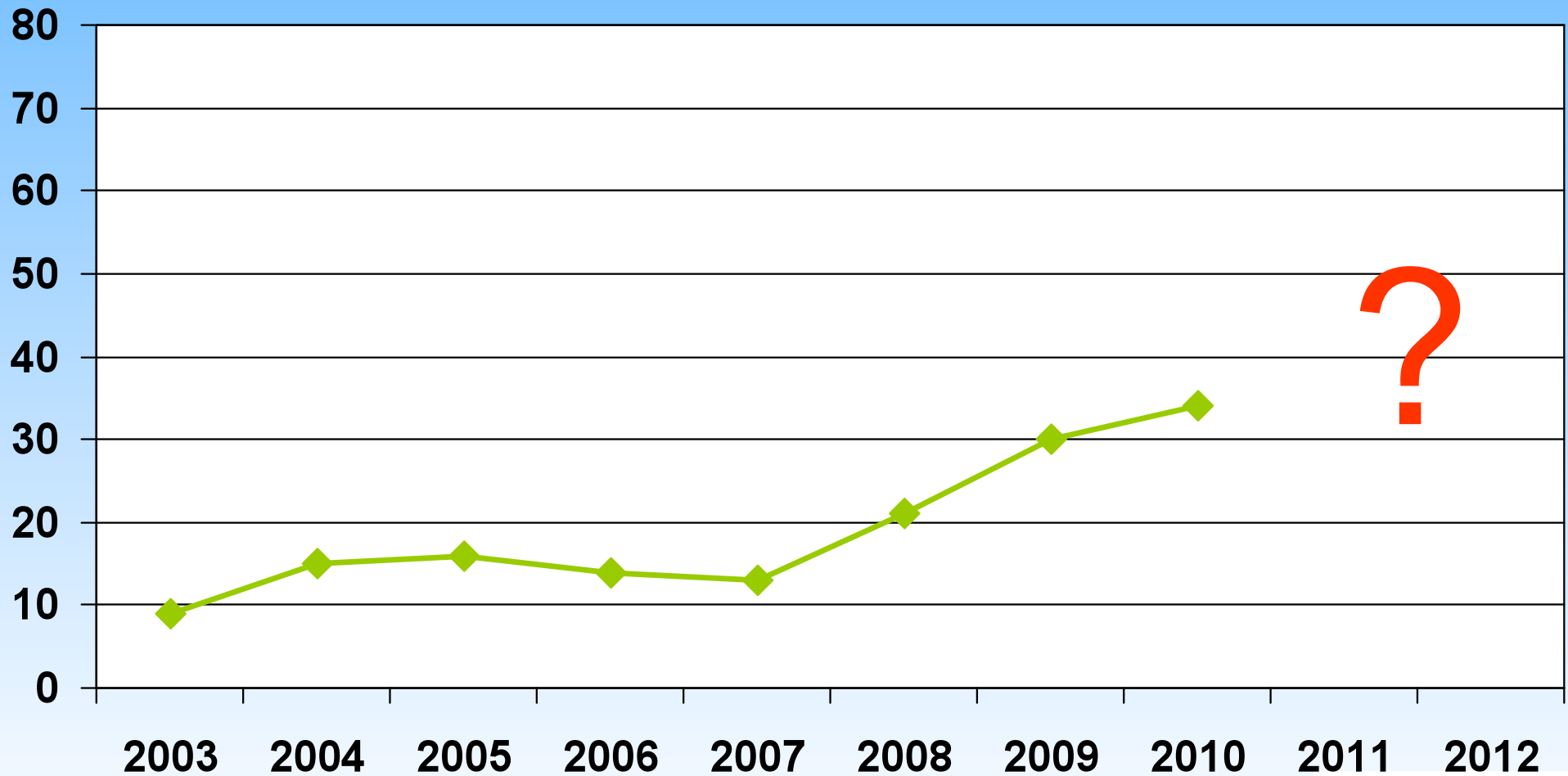
Members SSRE
